"The thing that strikes me most about 'The Christians' is that for all the struggle that the characters go through, there is no 'bad guy.' Every one of these characters is coming from a place of personal truth, of belief, and they struggle with reconciling the differences in their beliefs. There's this heartbreaking distance

between them that tugs at the soul. And one of the most wrenching questions that the play forces us to contemplate is what we should do when those we love believe something that is not only different from what we believe, but believe something that we feel is actually dangerous."




